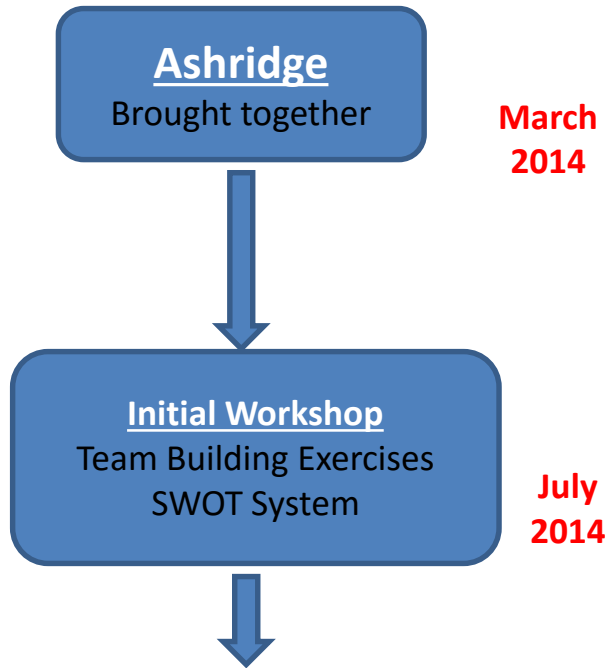

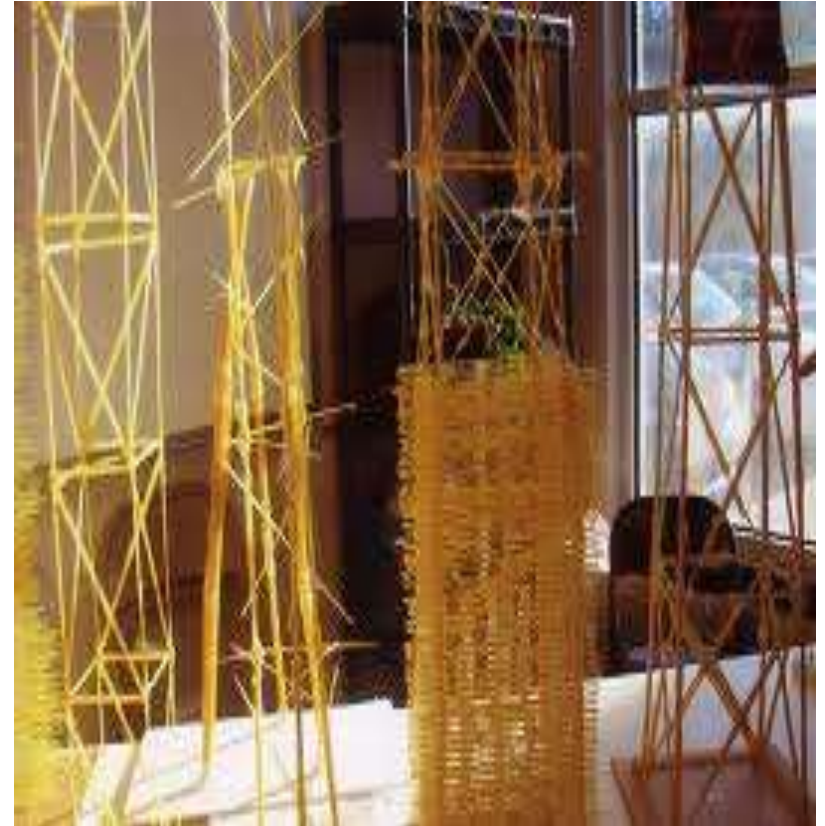
Commissioners, providers and academics from across the divide took up the mantle to make a difference and turned out in force

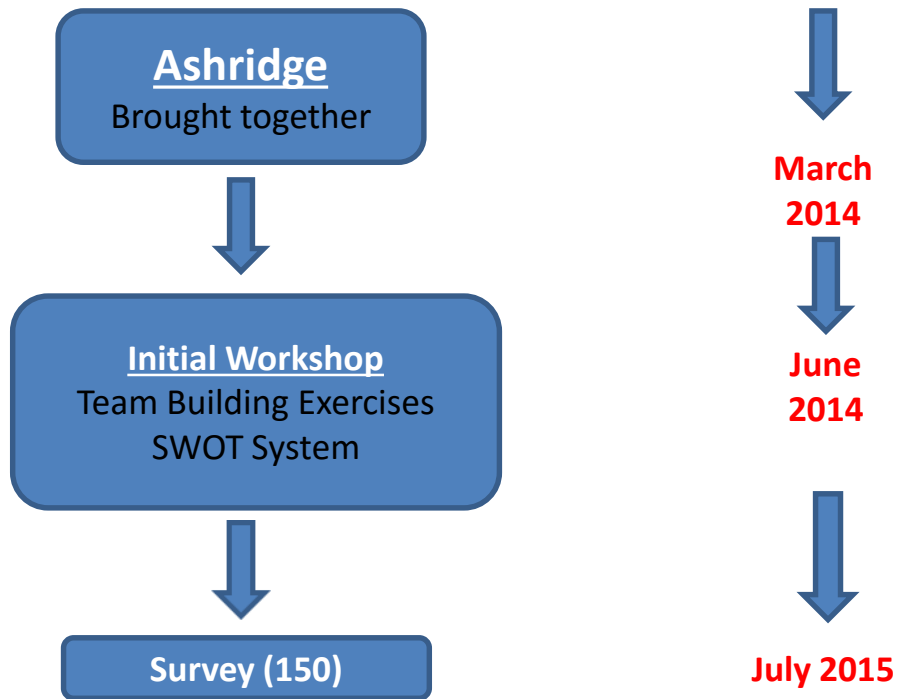
“For the first time ever we all took stock across the whole research pathway from inception to dissemination and in doing so the entire research system was exposed in a single afternoon...

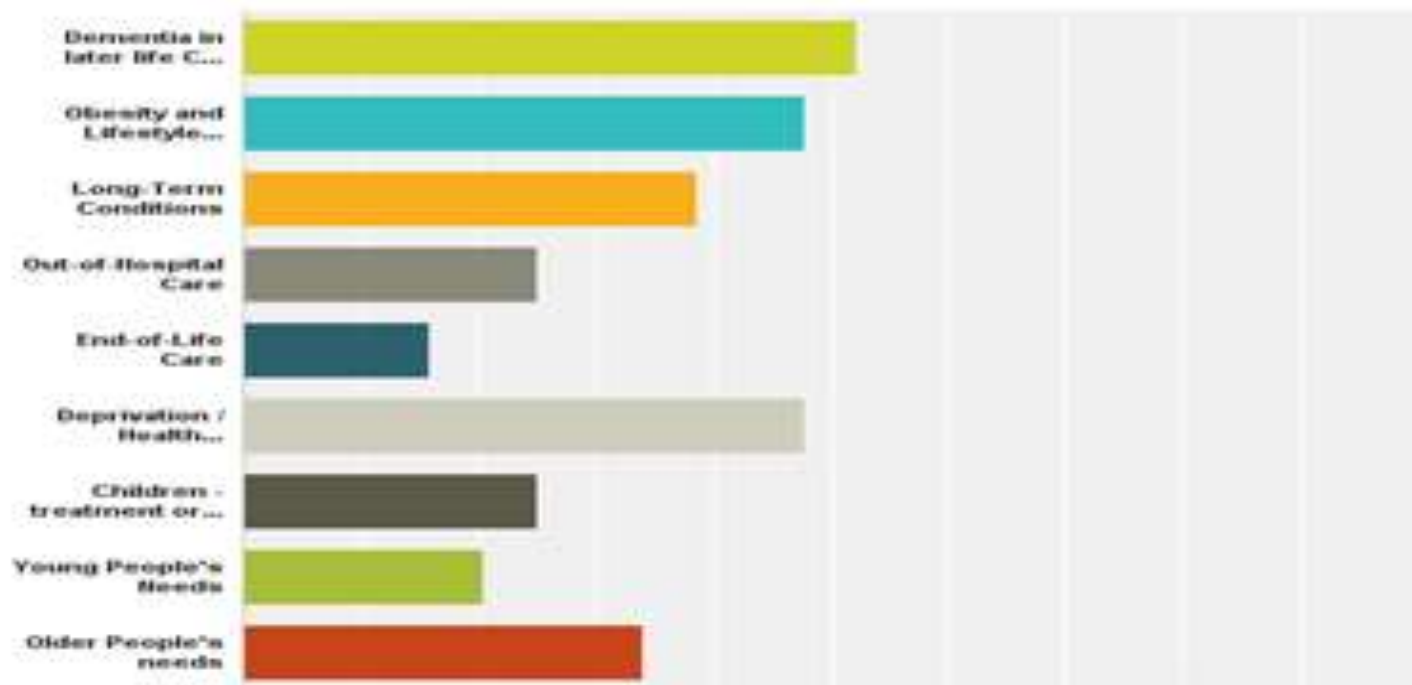

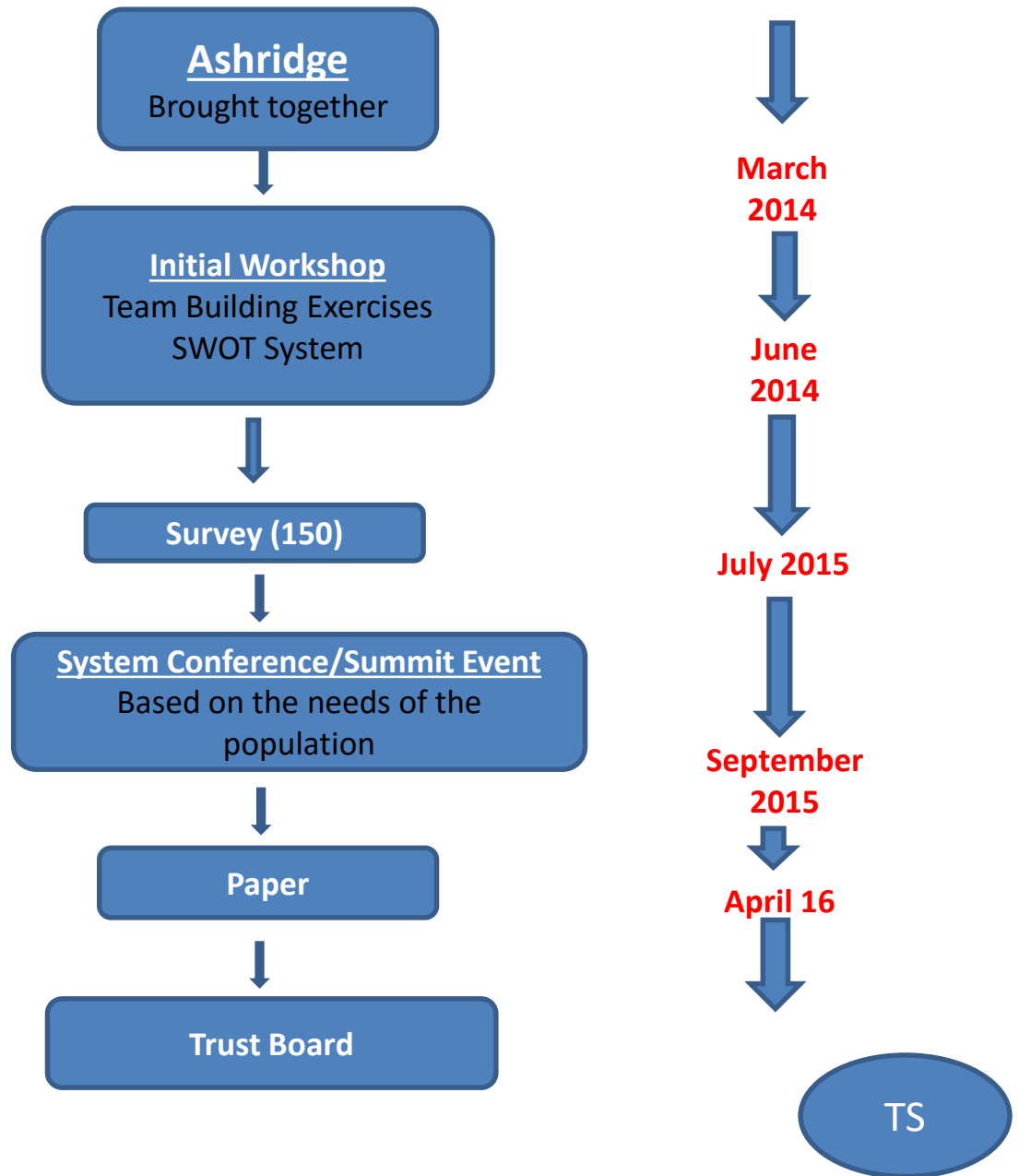
